SESSION SYNOPSIS OF JANUARY 24, 2024

The first Session Meeting of 2024 was a good one with all Elders ready to support the ministry & mission of the congregation. The meeting started off with the Elders presenting and discussing their individual results from the Myers-Briggs/Jung Typology test, a process that will help the Elders to know each other a little better and aid their ability to work well together.

Notable items and discussions from the first 2024 Meeting were:

In preparation for the **Annual Meeting of the Congregation** Session **approved**:

- 1) **Sunday, February 11th, 2024** immediately following worship, as the meeting date which allows for the required two-week notice to the congregation. [It will be an efficient meeting that will not require a lengthy time commitment from those attending.]
 - 2) **2023 Annual Report**, copies to be available, which does a great job of reviewing 2023 and all the meaningful things that this congregation and the ministry teams accomplished.
 - 3) **Church's finances** at the end of 2023 for congregation information to be reviewed.
 - 4) **2024 Budget**, as adopted by Session, to be presented for congregation information. [The congregation does not vote on the budget.]
 - 5) **Congregation Nominating Committee** nominees, those individuals charged with identifying members willing to serve in the key positions of Elder and Deacon, to be elected by the congregation.
 - 6) **Bylaws of FPCV**, as approved by Session, will be presented to the congregation for its approval.
 - 7) **Terms of Call for Pastor Kim**, as approved by Session, will be submitted for congregation approval.
- **A Financial Audit** was conducted in late 2023 and the Treasurer reported the audit went well with no findings of needed corrections. This was important because 2023 was a year of transition for our financial software systems and many new record keeping procedures. It was noted that the many hours of work by Treasurer Linda Long, with Business Manager Susan Davis, and with the Finance Team made the good audit results possible.
 - Welcoming of "Pastor" Julia and praise for her wonderful **Ordination service held January 7, 2024**. It was noted how blessed we are to have Pastor Julia as our Associate Pastor in Residence.
 - Recognition of the first application and issuance of **Sharing Table Funds**. **iEngage** applied via the application process for funding some new equipment to improve our streaming capability and quality, our audio quality, and some sanctuary monitors for better image quality.

Among the **Session Approvals** given after appropriate Motions with seconds, were:

- **Moving \$60,000** of the \$76,127 in funds received in 2023 that were in excess of 2023 expenses to an appropriate core account and identified as Operating Reserves.
- Establishing the process for bringing **requests from the ministry teams for Sharing Table Funds** to Session for review. All requests will first go to a Sharing Table team of Chris Hoham & Jim Hubbard to be put into a format with accompanying support documents before being presented for review and consideration by Session. (iEngage had the first request approved by Session for Sharing Table funds.)

- Allowing the **Sweet Adelines**, the choral group that practices in our Fellowship Hall each Tuesday evening, to hold a fundraising concert in Fellowship Hall on Sunday April 21, 2024. This approval was made under the Facility Use Policy in effect when the application was made. [A new, revised Facility Use Policy is currently under development.]
- Holding the traditional **Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper** on Tuesday, February 13, 2024 from 5PM to 7PM in Fellowship Hall. Funds raised will go to our Environmental Ministry (31290).
- Reinstating the past practice of having Session members hold a **potluck dinner with Confirmands** on the evening they hear the Faith Statements from Confirmands. This will allow for that personal interaction deemed important for supporting our young Confirmands.
- Introducing the congregation, via a letter to members, to a new initiative by iEngage to make First Presbyterian Valparaiso **a more welcoming congregation**. [The Sharing Table model, which began with an all-congregation general meeting, will be followed to clarify where we are and where we want to go in making FPCV a more welcoming building on our Mathew 25 Foundation.]
- Updating of a few of the Policies & Procedures for the **Presbyterian Church Resale Shop**, the ones related to how its leadership team is chosen and vacancies handled.

- Other reports were received from Pastor Kim, the Treasurer, the Director of Worship Music and Digital Technology, the Director of Faith Formation, the Associate Pastor in Residence and the Clerk Pro Tem of Session.

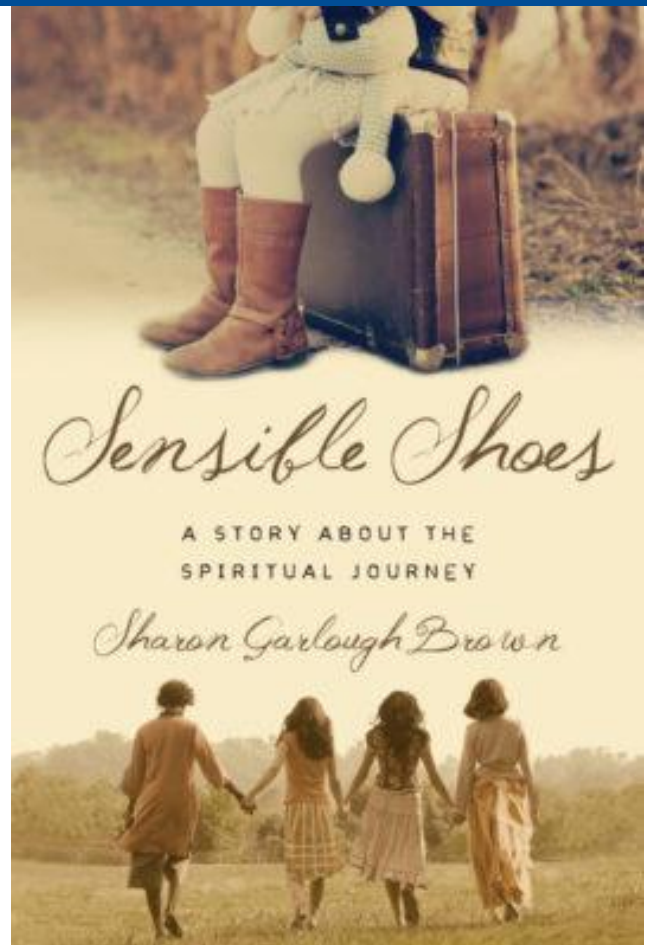
BOOK CLUB OPPORTUNITY

Life is busy. FPCV gets it! God's grace comes to us in the busyness. FPCV is pleased to offer drive-through Imposition of Ashes and blessing. Simply drive up to the FPCV Main Entrance during the timeframe above and a pastor will greet you at your car.



Mission is the heart of who we are as First Presbyterian Church! One of our brilliant art glass windows says “Go ye...” and we know the rest is “teach all nations...”. Meditate upon the messages of our sanctuary windows sometime in the quiet before worship. Jesus tells us, “Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me... Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me.”



One way we live out this message is through Matthew 25: Building congregational vitality, dismantling structural racism and eradicating systemic poverty.

Another is that each Sunday at the end of worship, we are sent out to do this work in our daily lives, wherever we may be found. It’s the “yes, and”...our response to worship and growing in understanding through God’s Word is to put the message of the Gospel into the world. Our actions give witness to our words and our faith in our Triune God. Hands and feet spread the Word.

Together, we do so much as First Pres! Our preschool and resale shop reach out into the community. We invite into our building the PADS program for men without housing, the Great Banquet community that plans retreat weekends and invites seekers to “come to the Banquet,” the Scouts, and other groups whose work is committed to love God and love our neighbor. We send funding where we cannot go, such as the small school in Kenya or major disaster sites.

This year the Mission Team is inviting new voices to join the team and its work of sharing stories of community needs and actions we can take that might begin to address those needs. We meet the second Tuesday each month at 6:30 pm in Room 101, with a Zoom option when unable to attend in person. What is your passion: welcoming immigrants to our community, teaching the children, affordable housing for low-income families, folks hungry toward the end of each month, better care for God’s green earth? Consider yourself invited!

2023 CHRISTIAN FOOD PANTRY MINISTRY

“I WAS HUNGRY AND YOU FED ME...” MATHEW 25:35

Having begun in 1982 by Charlie and Nan Steeves this was the 41st year of operation for the Christian Food Pantry! The first month 87 families were served. Today, support comes from the seven sponsoring churches and the community. The giving of all kinds from these sources continues to be very generous.

The pantry greatly appreciates the generosity of the First United Methodist Church for providing the space in the Asbury Center for the pantry operations. The space and co-operation shared with The Shop is greatly valued! The two projects work well together.

We are most thankful for the 20+ dedicated volunteers that continue to serve faithfully. VOLUNTEERS ARE OUR GREATEST ASSET! Seven volunteers work every Monday and Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. or later. MANY extra hours are spent shopping, picking up donations, sorting food, stocking shelves and ‘housekeeping’ as well as compiling reports, keeping records and paying bills. Personal notes are sent to organizations and individuals outside the sponsoring congregations who donate money or food.

During the summer school vacation, two hundred sixty-nine Kids’ Kits containing extra food and treats were given to families with children ages 5 to 16.

The Valparaiso community came through with extra help for holiday giving. Food, health, cleaning items, etc. were collected by various groups and organizations. Holiday dinner menu items were offered: Seventy-one families picked up Easter hams and dinner items. Sixty-nine families received Thanksgiving turkey and foods. Ninety-nine families chose either a ham or a turkey to supplement dinner menu items for Christmas.

Kits for soups, salads, goulash and pies were sometimes offered as extra specials.
