#### SESSION SYNOPSIS OF DECEMBER 2, 2019

This last meeting of 2019 was bittersweet as four outstanding Elders have completed their three-year terms and will be leaving the Session. Pastor Kim gave thanks for Rhonda Coffin, Barry Hughes, Jerry Kahrs, and Connie Knauff; many others also expressed their gratitude for the countless ways in which these four have served faithfully, often behind the scenes. Please join us in thanking them for their countless hours of service and dedication which have definitely made FPCV a better place to worship our God!

There were again introductions of newly elected officers who had been unable to attend the previous meeting. Elder-elect Kim Croarkin, Deacons-elect Paul Knauff and Nancy Porter, and Youth Deacon-elect Owen Crews each commented on why they have answered God's call and how they hope to contribute their own unique gifts to the body which is our church.

One of the most important items on the agenda was the adoption of the **2020 Budget**. Three options were prepared and presented by the Finance Team. Motion was made and seconded to approve Option #3, a Faith Budget, where actual revenues in excess of budget estimates will be allocated to Mission. Following in-depth discussion and responses to questions, this budget option was approved and will be presented and explained to the Congregation at the Annual Meeting in January.

In addition, Session approved two financial requests, one to pay for a Presbyterian Polity course which Director of Christian Education Ken Crews is required to take in order to be ordained; and a second to allow an increase in iEngage spending for advertising to promote our Holiday and Christmas activities.

Several Personnel issues were covered as well. These included the Medical Flexible Spending Account (FSA) for our full-time employees with benefits; performance evaluations of all paid staff; an appreciation event at Pastor Kim's to recognize the good work of all our paid employees; and an amended Terms of Call for Pastor Kim which will be presented to the Congregation at the Annual Meeting in January. If you have any personnel questions, you may address these to Jim Hubbard who is serving as Personnel Moderator *pro tem*.

#### Session Synopsis of December 2, 2019, continued

Much additional business was conducted during this last meeting of the year:

- A Congregational Meeting has been called for December 8, 2019, at the conclusion of the 9:00 a.m. service, for the purpose of receiving the Congregational Nominating Team's report on the nomination to fill a vacancy in the Deacon Class of 2020
- ➤ One Family Reunion Services have been reinstated. When there is a fifth Sunday of the month, a One Family Reunion Service will begin at 10:00 a.m., beginning December 2019.
- ➤ Jim Hubbard distributed a draft document of our **Manual of Operations** (which is requested by Presbytery). After reviewing its history and scope, Jim plans to contact Team Moderators and assist with the completion of the information needed for this manual which should be completed in 2020.
- ➤ Lisa Pavlopoulos has humbly responded to God's call to serve as our new **Moderator of Stewardship**. Lisa has several new ideas and is excited to promote Stewardship as a way of worshiping God.
- There will be **New Member Classes** offered on Sunday mornings during the month of February. These classes will be for those wishing to join the church as well as for those who have joined FPC in recent years but were unable to attend New Member Classes.

A few additional items are also worthy of note:

- ➤ Kids are not the future of the church as some have said. *Kids ARE the church!* And the presence of so many children in worship is evidence of our CE Team and Director of Christian Education and Youth Ministry doing things right! Kids are involved in many worship activities: performing as acolytes, providing Children's Chats, serving as Liturgists, singing in Choir, ringing the Handbells.
- ➤ Prayers are requested for volunteers to step up into the administrative leadership roles for our PADS Ministry as it continues to move forward.
