SESSION SYNOPSIS OF JUNE 16, 2021

There was a lot to celebrate at this month's Session meeting. Most importantly, Session met IN-PERSON! What a joy to meet, greet, and speak face to face with each other after nearly a year and a half apart, and do God's work TOGETHER!

This month, Elders have been praying for the Worship Team as part of their Holy Living mission. There have definitely been challenges for this team as they began live streaming the outdoor service. In the process, the team learned that being prayed for allowed them to do things that they didn't know they could do, didn't feel qualified to do, but were *successful* in doing because the prayers and the Holy Spirit enabled it all to happen! Due to continuing issues surrounding Covid, there are still concerns the team is trying to address, and they are grateful for your patience and trust as they move forward. Another realization was that had we not endured the pain/discomfort/suffering of the past year, we might not have appreciated as much the great joy of again laughing together, singing together, and worshiping together in the pavilion (with the breezes; fragrant smells of cut grass and flowers; and the outdoor sounds of birds? lawn mowers? crickets? sirens?).

One of the greatest blessings was the announcement that our own **Bill Rogers**, who has been a ministry candidate under our care in the Presbytery, has successfully completed all work necessary for him to become an Ordained Minister of the Word and Sacrament in the Presbyterian Church. This will take place in our sanctuary on July 25, at 2:00 PM. The entire FPC Valpo family is invited to attend (and wear RED in celebration) as we wish Bill well as he begins his ministry serving as Covenant Pastor to both First Presbyterian Church in Portage and Bethel Union Mills Presbyterian Church. More details concerning this ordination service will be forthcoming.

Several motions were passed, including the following:

- ➤ Elected **Elizabeth Monroe** to the position of Membership Clerk as Susan Grosick is retiring from that position after more than five years of service;
- Affirmed the email vote to follow CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19 and allow fully vaccinated people to have the option of not wearing masks or maintaining physical social distancing in most settings;
- ➤ Disbanded the Community Task Force which has done such a remarkable job in the face of all the Covid challenges; this effectively returns all decision-making and research to the Session as a whole;

- ➤ Pastors not on the Presbytery's Pulpit Supply List may be invited to preach as long as they have been ordained in a denomination that the PC(USA) is in full covenant with;
- And while not a motion, Elders spent time **reviewing the membership rolls** as required by the Book of Order. Following the past year of *no one* attending worship in person, Elders felt it was important to make an effort to personally contact some members who have not been as actively involved in church activities over the past several years, and in some cases, recommended that Deacons make additional contacts as well.

Joys and Concerns included the birth of a grandson, celebration of a 5-year anniversary following a daughter-in-law's successful heart transplant, several graduating seniors, and the many familiar *and* new faces we have seen in worship. And if you see member Melissa Klancer running around town, be sure to congratulate her on having qualified for and been accepted as a member of the Michael J. Fox team that runs marathons to raise funds for Parkinson's Disease!

Also, be sure to congratulate Pastor Nancy as she is celebrating 40 years as an Ordained Minister of the Word and Sacrament. We are blessed and thankful for her service to God.

RESALE SHOP NEWS

The Presbyterian Resale Shop had a great month of May. We logged about 1,000 volunteer hours, took in \$7,180 in sales and donated \$6,200 to local charities.

We are taking advantage of summer events in the downtown area by offering extended shopping hours for the upcoming Art Festival on June 26, the Wine Festival on July 24, and Sidewalk Sales on July 30 and 31.
