SESSION SYNOPSIS OF APRIL 22, 2020

YOUR ELDERS MISS YOU! That was the overwhelming message expressed at last Wednesday's Session meeting via Zoom. It is the Session's responsibility to not only govern and guide the congregation but also to "nurture the covenant community of disciples of Christ" (Book of Order, G-3.0201c); and during this challenging pandemic, it has been so difficult for them to do that! In recent weeks, both Elders and Deacons have been contacting the membership, and while that helps, it simply cannot replace the face-to-face communication (smiles, hugs, updates, sharing, etc.) that happens when we all gather together.

Much thanks and praise was offered to the Worship and iEngage Teams (and also Pastor Kim, CED Ken, and Church Administrator Dawn) who have been working tireless hours to create and present our online worship and meeting opportunities. Unfortunately, as you are now probably aware, these online gatherings must continue through the end of May (with Session revisiting the orders at their May 20 meeting). As much as everyone wants to return to normal routines, that is not likely to happen. Our "new normal" way of doing church will be different! And while your Session doesn't have all the answers yet, they are certainly working on ways to help us worship and continue our work in the community and the world.

The first step in the process of determining this new normal has been to create a **TASK FORCE** that will establish the plans for moving forward gradually once we do receive governmental approval to reopen and deem it safe for our members. Several steps have already been taken, and the Task Force will certainly keep you informed when they are able to move forward.

In other business, several actions were taken:

- Elders moved that a request be submitted to the Smock Deacons Fund for an additional \$5,000 to be used to help members with COVID-19 related needs;
- iEngage has applied for a grant to purchase iPads on which worship services can be downloaded and then be shared with members who do not have access to the Internet or WiFi;
- There will be information placed on both the church website and our FaceBook page relating to the 2020 Census; because so many of the populations which we support (children, the homeless, those suffering from poverty, etc.) are served based on Census figures, it is extremely important for us to encourage everyone to complete the Census forms.

If you would like more information, please read the detailed minutes which are *posted in the glass-enclosed announcement board* in the Hospitality Center once they are approved (and we allowed back into the church!). Also feel free to contact any of the Elders and/or the Clerk if you have questions or are interested in further details.
