BRANDING STORY FOR LENT-EASTER LOGO

In the logo, the two hands reaching toward each other represent our longing for connection despite the politics, assumptions, beliefs, and narratives that divide us. The hands look as if they are reaching in for a handshake, but they are paused just before they connect. The negative space in between the hands creates the shape of a doorway, symbolizing hospitality or a pathway forward. The doorway invites us to look for God in the spaces in between. In the typography, the “in” is bracketed, emphasizing the promise that God shows up in surprising ways and unexpected places, but is present in it all. The shape of the hands further echoes the bracket shape. Grammatically, brackets are used to provide additional explanation or information. The brackets around the [in] represent the charge to each of us: to dig deeper into complexity and nuance, to ask questions and stay curious, and to be open to where God might meet us along the way.

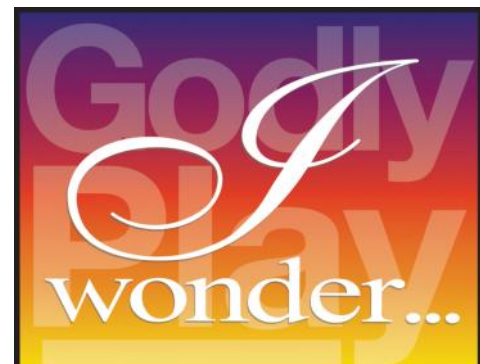

PADS MINISTRY INFORMATION

PADS (Public Action to Distribute Shelter) was started in 2005 by the Valparaiso Christian Ministerial Association homeless coalition. The Christian community in Valparaiso worked together. New Creation was established in 2010 to provide support services in order to help individuals experiencing homelessness work towards becoming self-sufficient. Over 5,500 men have been served since the beginning.

PADS is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing emergency shelter for men in our community. PADS offers a comprehensive approach to combating homelessness with the compassion and respect all deserve.

FPCV hosted PADS on Wednesday evening 6:00 PM through Thursday morning 7:00 AM during the winter months, October 15 to April 15.

FPCV was transformed each Wednesday so that we could serve dinner that evening, provide a warm and comfortable place to sleep and serve breakfast on Thursday morning. This year, we averaged 8-12 men per week.

PADS is for men only, who are in the program at New Creation to help them find jobs and housing so that they no longer need to be part of the PADS program. In the past years many men have succeeded in finding jobs and housing. We celebrate them!

FPCV is a cooperative effort with other area congregations and the community in general. St Andrews Church and Trinity Lutheran Church have helped FPCV with volunteers, dinners, bedding and supplies for many years.

Starting February 1, 2025, PADS has ended with the opening of the Daybreak homeless Shelter. The shelter serves as the primary shelter for the men who were in PADS/New Creation program. The shelter includes a Warming Center for those men, women and children who need a safe place to be protected from the weather but are not part of the primary shelter services.

This list is a partial list of volunteers through the years, my notes start in 2012. There are many I have missed. Many from other churches have helped.

MEALS ARE REALLY NEEDED:

To help please visit www.daybreakvalpo.org, click on the volunteer drop down menu, then click on meals and signup on any available day. For the next week or two, they do not have a kitchen as they are waiting on health department inspection. So you can bring meals in and serve them for about 20 guests at 5:00 p.m. There are plates, silverware, glasses, utensils etc. available at the facility. Grateful for all.
