

Everywhere I go, I hear Carrie Newcomer's lyrics running through my mind and heart. What a joy it was, and a privilege for us, to host her for the day in late September, and invite a few – hundred – of our friends to join us in listening, wondering, laughing, and seeking.

And it took a small village of people willing to get behind this crazy, hair-brained idea that we could bring an artist of such caliber to our humble sanctuary. Born in the midst of a Building Disciples team meeting, Linda Long quickly headed up a committee of folks – from Building Disciples, from Finance and Mission, from iEngage... and it happened! As Carrie spoke, "It is impossible... until it is not."



As I write this, the numbers have not yet been finalized. A tremendous support of underwriting from both the Presbytery of Wabash Valley, as well as our own Finance wizards, will enable us to send a check to The Caring Place in support of their services which serve victims of domestic violence, somewhere in the neighborhood of \$4,000. \$4,000!

I am overwhelmed, and yet I should not be. Because the folks here at FPC continue to step up to challenges, to step into the gap, to join God where God is already at work, bringing light, bringing hope.

Carrie quoted author Parker Palmer (you really should check out some of his books!) when he wrote, "Hope is holding in creative tension everything that is with what could and should be, and everyday taking some action to narrow the distance between the two."

We lived out hope, in taking action to narrow the gap between what is, and what could and should be. Thanks be to God for such living and witness, giving us a glimpse of the Kingdom even here, even now!

Session Synopsis of September 17, 2018

Session always begins meetings with a short period of devotion and opening prayer, often centering on some aspect of concern for the officers to consider. This month, Connie Knauff, co-moderator of the Christian Education Team, presented several ideas regarding the issues our Sunday school program has faced over the last few years. Key here is the idea that perhaps we need to take the "school" out of "Sunday School!" Instead of making faith something to study and work at, we should be showing our children faith in action and helping them develop their relationships with God and each other. To that end, CE is investigating the mentoring of our children by others within the church; you will definitely hear much more in the future.

Session has also called for a <u>Congregational Meeting for Sunday</u>, <u>September 30</u>, following the 9:00 a.m. worship service for the purpose of receiving the report of the Congregational Nominating Team for the Elder Class of 2021, Deacon Class of 2021, and Deacon Class of 2019. At this time, the report includes the following individuals: Elders Richard Exley, Jacki Phillips, Ken McAloon, and Lisa Pavlopoulos, and Deacons Mary Brown and Karen Vogelsang. They will be introduced and elected at the meeting and then begin their preparations to take office in January 2019.

Our Finance Team is doing a great job! Moderator Elizabeth Monroe updated Elders on our current financial status which is positive and healthy. She was also able to announce that the annual Outside Review of the Financial Statements (audit) for 2017 was successfully completed by our own Mr. Ralph Pollaro, CPA, on August 17. She reminded Moderators that 2019 Budget requests are due by October 1 when the Finance and Stewardship Teams will crunch the numbers for next year.

Pastor Mark and Elders were in conversation about several additional topics including:

There will be one service of worship at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, December 2, 2018, to be followed by the <u>Hanging of the Greens</u> event and luncheon.

- The Annual Review of Membership (required by the Book of Order) was presented by Membership Clerk Susan Grosick; several Elders will be making personal contacts.
- Former Elder Jim Hubbard has done a tremendous amount of work on a Manual of Operations for our church. Draft copies of this document were distributed so that Moderators can begin to sift through the information and being work on their individual sections. This will be an on-going and long-term project, but a very important one which will delineate the specific policies of FPC Valparaiso in relation to the PC (USA) Book of Order.
- Elders discussed concerns and ways to express compassion and help to some in our congregation who might need special consideration and/or care.
- Personnel Moderator Chip Wilkes advised Elders on current employment issues.





WHY


