#### SESSION SYNOPSIS OF APRIL 29, 2019

In the days since we celebrated Easter, the presence of the Risen Christ has been felt in many ways in and around First Presbyterian Church. Elders began this Session meeting with devotions centered on some of those experiences in their own lives, and Pastor Nancy opened with prayer praising God for His continued presence as we recall Christ's resurrection as well as wait in anticipation for the pastor who will be called to fill our pulpit in the near future.

First on the docket was welcoming Rev. Jennifer Burns Lewis, the Visioning and Connecting Leader of our Presbytery. Pastor Nancy had invited her to lead this month's Elder Training, which is prescribed by the Book of Order. Jennifer presented the first lesson in a series about Being Presbyterian (produced by the Synod of Mid America) on Preparation for Ordered Ministry. Discussion included some of the following points:

- ➤ Elders and Deacons are not *above* other members of the congregation, but *set apart* by God for their particular ministries;
- ➤ Elders and Deacons are to *love the church* as Christ loves the church;
- ➤ Elders and Deacons are to *stop*, *listen*, *and discern* what God is saying;
- ➤ Deacons are the "face of Christ" to the congregation, visiting and ministering along with the pastor;
- ➤ Elders are tasked with helping the congregation to "faithfully follow" the will of God as it is discerned by the Session.

As Jennifer explained, this series is appropriate for ALL Presbyterians, not just your officers, and she encouraged the congregation also to visit the website **theocademy.com** and become familiar with the options. Excellent information is available not only for Deacons and Elders but also includes topics and

study guides for Bible Study lessons, Confirmation classes, and much more. Session will likely continue to examine these videos during future trainings.

In other business, Session addressed several topics:

- ➤ Worship Team has determined that there will only be two worship services during the summer months. The Contemporary service will be moved to 10:15 a.m. while the Traditional service will be moved to 8:30 a.m. The earlier service will meet in the Sanctuary on the first and third Sundays and meet outside in the Pavilion the second, fourth, and fifth Sundays. This recommendation came after much discussion and compromise: to accommodate those who so very much enjoy the Pavilion outdoor service while at the same time taking into consideration that without a pastor we are using Pulpit Supply ministers.
- Building & Grounds co-chair Barry Hughes presented a proposal to repair/repave the parking lot (which was approved as a Capital Project), so look for those repairs to take place in the near future.
- Christian Education chair Connie Knauff updated Elders on both plans for the Confirmation Banquet (May 8)/Confirmation Sunday (May 19) and also the plans for the Playground Dedication, also on Sunday, May 19. Watch for updates in bulletins and email blasts.

If you would like more information, please read the detailed minutes which are *posted in the glass-enclosed announcement board* in the Hospitality Center once they are approved. Also feel free to contact any of the Elders and/or the Clerk if you have questions or are interested in further details.

#### LIBRARY NEWS, CONTINUED

#### **UPDATE**

Here's a brief history of our church library; some recent activity and some varied solutions. Library needs several people who will make team decisions, but also for each person to take on an individual area of responsibility.

**LIBRARY HISTORY**: In the past, there was a library shelved in the Hospitality Center, then it was moved to Room 100 where small groups meet. Georgia Coyle joined the church in 2014, had a librarian background, and initiated updating and moving the library to its current location. She entered the Church Triumphant in 2017.

#### RECENT LIBRARY BACKGROUND:

Articles in Monthly Tidings hoped to increase interest and usage of library. May 2019 article asked for **part-time librarian** to volunteer a few flexible hours a month. Article retired Birthday Books until a later date in time.

Birthday Book Club initiated by Georgia Coyle hoped to expand children's section. (We initiated addition of new children's books & expanded.) I think she would be gratified. We added new hardcover children's books and have 50 honorees. Children's table and chairs added near children's shelving with puzzles, magazines for kids. A rolling cart with children's books traveled around the halls of the church to encourage interest in the library and provides an easy check-out for children's books on the cart. (Cart retired to CE Storeroom for now.)

Month of March Birthdays Rolling Cart featured Birthday Book members who had March birthdays.

GIFT BAG DRAWING: April users of the library were entered into a gift bag drawing; winner was drawn May 1. (Winner was PWNS... they received a gift bag including a Hobby Lobby gift card, a book and little treasures for the kids.)

**HELPERS:** Joan Johnston changes adult books on a shelf in the Hospitality Room. She faithfully re-

shelves the returned books, and updates the library calendar and the seasonal decorations.

**NEXT STEP SUGGESTIONS:** Utilizing a team of volunteers.

CONTINUE A (LIMITED) BIRTHDAY BOOK CLUB (via donor request only): Display is located on the shelf in the Hospitality Center. Expand selections from only children's to include youth and adult books.

CULL/OFFER ADOPT UNUSED SHELVED BOOKS. Many books are never checked out. Solution: Offer up unneeded books to adopt; by who gave the book... then to other people/places. (More shelving not needed.)

**SORT DROPPED-OFF BOOKS** (donated which are in the library but not processed): keep some for library inclusion, then give away to Resale or Free Pile, etc.

#### **Possible Solutions:**

**Don't Do Anything.** Let it be what it is for now.

**FORM UP A GROUP OF HELPERS** to make decisions and carry them out. ARE YOU INTERESTED???

**ELIMINATE SIGN OUTS:** Consider just using the library as a no-record system.

**ASK OTHER MINISTRY TEAMS** to adopt responsibility for the Library. (Christian Ed has the responsibility currently.)

**Ask for a Session Decision** as to what should be done with the Library.

I need to take a less active role, but I would like to pass along what I have learned, and hope that there are folks who can help out the Library.


