

Dear Beloved Community,

What an interesting, and at times, difficult, season it is to be in ministry. Our world feels increasingly divided. Freedom of speech is a gift, but too often it is misused in ways that wound instead of heal. Social media in particular emboldens us to say things we might never speak face-to-face, and anger too quickly escalates into hate.

Years ago, when Jason and I went to see *Star Wars: The Phantom Menace* in the theatre, Yoda, my favorite character, spoke a line that has stayed with me ever since: "Fear leads to anger, anger leads to hate, hate leads to suffering." There's deep wisdom here. Fear of what we don't understand can grow into anger, and anger, if left unchecked, can harden into hate. Hate doesn't just wound others, it corrodes our own souls.

As followers of Christ, we are called to another way. Paul reminds us: "Put aside all bitterness, losing your temper, anger, shouting, and slander, along with every other evil. Be kind, compassionate, and forgiving to each other, in the same way God forgave you in Christ" (Ephesians 4:31–32, CEB). Even when we fall short, and all of us do, God still sees us as beloved. And if God sees us this way, we are called to see one another as beloved too.

October itself reminds us of God's goodness breaking in. The beauty of the leaves turning, the abundance of autumn foods, the joy of Halloween laughter, all of it is a reminder that grace is never far away.

First Presbyterian Church, will gather on Sunday, October 19, for Celebration Sunday. On that day, we will pledge our giving for 2026 and share a meal together, not to boast in our own achievements, but to celebrate the work God is doing among us and through us. Our stewardship theme this year is "For Good" inspired by the song of the same name in the musical, *Wicked*. We are here, not for hate, not for fear, but for good. Stewardship is about caring faithfully for what has been entrusted to us, whether it's the earth with its changing seasons, the neighbors God calls us to love, or the vibrant ministries of our church.

This October, may we remember that even in a world where anger is loud, goodness is louder still. God has placed us here for good, to be people of compassion, generosity, and joy.

PLANNED GIVING

HAVE YOU THOUGHT ABOUT A WILL?

This past August was National Make-A-Will Month. Annually, the month of August is designated for this purpose. I certainly saw a number of articles in the newspaper and on-line promoting the making of a Will during August. Reading an article by Chris White the CEO for Northwest Indiana United Way, he states that Wills are "more than documents – but a peace of mind." Common reasons given for completing a Will are the following.



- 1) Protect your children by naming guardians.
- 2) Support your spouse or partner by ensuring financial security.
- 3) Reduce conflict among family members by clearly stating your wishes.
- 4) Leave a legacy by designating a gift to a cause or organization close to your heart.

Seventy percent of adult Americans do not have Wills. A carefully written one has many benefits as outlined above. A Will can conserve your estate, expedite settlement, and creatively care for those you love. A Will can also provide an avenue for you to support those charities and non-profits that you have passionately supported during your lifetime. First Presbyterian is an example that you can support forever through a Will.

When Connie and I were in our 20's, we probably did not think much about a Will. However, when our oldest daughter was born, our thinking changed. We had a Will written primarily for the purpose of providing guardianship for our children. Now we are in our 70's and 80's, our children are adults providing for themselves, and we still see the need for a Will or Estate Plan. Some think writing a Will is complicated. It is not. Modern day tools can now allow one to write their own Will in less than an hour. Also, many competent, caring attorneys are available in our community to assist with writing a Will.

A Will is a cornerstone or framework for providing for our loved ones whether it is a spouse, children, grandchildren, or church family. It is never too early or too late to have one written. The question again is, Have You Thought About a Will?

BUILDING AND GROUNDS



Heating, Air Conditioning & Parking Lot Projects:

As you know your B+G's Team works continuously maintaining First Presbyterian Church to provide a safe, comfortable and beautiful environment for our Faith Community Worship, Mission and Christian Education.

Following almost five (5) years of study and temporary repair work we are at the end of any continuation of cost-effective and efficient heating and cooling maintenance.

The situation has become critical as we currently have no Air Conditioning (AC) and irregular heat in the Sanctuary and no heat or AC in the Chapel, Narthex and Hospitality center. Along with these failed systems our thirty (30) year old Main Office and Fellowship Hall heating and cooling systems have reached the end of their life expectancy and could also fail at any time.

On September 11th your Session Elders approved major repairs and upgrades to our fifty (50) year old boiler and air conditioning systems. They have also approved the much-needed repaving of our south, main, parking lot.

Last August your Finance Team, with Jim Hubbard, presented a brief update in First Notes regarding these improvements and I'll let them provide more financial details; however, I can now say that these major projects will cost almost \$800,000 will be financed with both Sharing Table Funds and a Mortgage Loan. The split between funding sources will be approximately 56% Sharing Table and 44% mortgage.

These projects will start very soon and will involve both heat and air conditioning in the Sanctuary, Chapel, Narthex, Hospitality Center, Fellowship Hall and Main office. These areas will be weaned off the two (2) boiler heating system to be replaced with high efficiency heating units and new rooftop AC units. At this time one (1) boiler will be operating to provide floor heat for the Nursery and Preschool and all of the north and north-west Classrooms, Faith Formation Office, Library and storage room general heat.

We don't anticipate any physical work being done in the major areas as listed; however, there will be no heat or air conditioning for a few weeks. The majority of construction will take place in equipment room 138 and up on the roof; however, the east end of the north hallway of the education wing is closed off at door "E".

We are still not sure of the actual working schedule as this type of project is a very fluid situation and dates are most likely going to change; however, the general contractor has estimated approximately 8-10 weeks of work from start to finish. We are looking at a very busy fall activity calendar and there are various events that will be affected.

For safety reasons office staff and Pre-school classes will occasionally be moved into other areas of the facility.

Our annual Deacon Cookie Walk is approaching fast! Deacons have been baking treats and cookies for several years now, raising funds for the charitable work we do.

Just place them in a sandwich size zip lock bag and drop off Friday, November 7, 2025, at the kitchen church **from 4:00 p.m. onward** or early the day of the Craft Fair November 8.

In addition to the Cookie Walk, the Deacons have also provided a gift bag to several shut-ins in our church family during the Advent season.

We are also reaching out to anyone who would like to help provide 16 identical gifts that are pre-wrapped for our deacon friends. Such gifts can include personal care items such as magnifying glass, socks, puzzles, candy, cookies, hot chocolate etc. Anything thoughtful and creative would be great!
