### YOU ARE WELCOME TO PLANT THE BUTTERFLY!

The butterfly is a handmade item from paper formed one sheet at a time in Seattle. They are made with 100% post industrial waste and are 100% tree free, acid free fiber. Embedded in this stock is our unique North American Wildflower seed blend. The seeds include Snapdragon, Petunia, Beardtongue, Daisy, Thyme, Poppy, Foxglove, Catchfly, Maiden Pinks and Chamomile.

Plant directly into the soil in a pot or in your garden. The dirt should be firmed down after sowing and the seeds should not be more than 1/8 inch deep. Keep moist for 4-6 weeks and ensure 4 hours of sunlight each day in order to germinate properly. The plants can grow as tall as three feet.
