

# SESSION SYNOPSIS OF NOVEMBER 29, 2023

Many thanks are extended to Pastor Nancy Becker who served as Moderator of this late November Session meeting. There was a lot to discuss, but she kept discussions moving and called for votes in a timely manner. We are grateful for her leadership.

We are also grateful for the leadership of many in our congregation who have taken on positions at the Presbytery level. At the November 27 Assembly meeting, several of our own were selected:

- Matthew Byerly elected as Moderator of Mission and Outreach of Presbytery
- Matthew Byerly also elected as a Commissioner to the 226<sup>th</sup> General Assembly
- Linda Long elected Reader for Ordination Exams in 2024
- ➤ Pastor Kim elected as co-Moderator of the Administrative Commission for the Kouts Presbyterian Church
- ➤ Elder *Ryne Press* and former member *Pastor Bill Rogers* elected as members of that same Administrative Commission
- > Jeff Whitney introduced as the new part-time Director for Tech Ministry
- And our Pastor in Residence *Julia Zhao* presented an articulate, personal, and moving sermon about baptism, experienced a successful Q & A style examination by Presbytery, and received a unanimous vote of approval for her ordination

Elders were also pleased and impressed with their examination of Deacons-Elect *Beth Germann* and *Jean Patton*. Official officer training took place earlier in November, but as the Book of Order requires, elders posed several questions as part of their examination. Both gave impressive responses to questions such as how their faith has evolved; what are the big issues facing the global church today; and how have significant events in their lives changed their journeys with God. Elders unanimously approved Beth and Jean to their ministry as Deacons, and they will be ordained/installed January 7, 2024, along with Elders-Elect who were examined last month.

Another highlight of the meeting was a presentation by Elder-Elect Jerry Kahrs concerning a major Building & Grounds issue. He gave an update on the HVAC situation, especially the problem of no heat in either the offices or the Chapel. After discussing long-term needs, cost increases, and feedback from the Trane Corporation, Elders approved a motion to allocate not more than \$4,000.00 to proceed with plans to provide heat for the offices. The decision was made to defer Chapel expenditures for the time being as other options are being pursued. One of those options is the exploration of a Solar/Renewable Energy plan. Statistics, graphs, and a video of how this can work led Elders to approve another motion, if the way be clear, to continue to pursue a solar/ renewable energy proposal. This could also dovetail with working toward an advantageous "Earth Care Congregation" designation that is available from the PC(USA). Elders agreed that both of these proposals sounded positive and exciting.

Several other important **motions** were considered:

Motion to call for the Annual Meeting of the Congregation for January 28, 2024 (approved)

#### > Personnel

- Recommends a 3% pay raise for all non-clergy staff in 2024 (staff evaluations were compiled and reviewed and were very positive) (approved)
- Ompensation package for Associate Pastor in Residence Julia Zhao was presented and approved and will be included in the Annual Report
- Recommends a 3% pay raise for Pastor Kim in 2024 based on her outstanding reviews (exceeds expectations in all areas!) (approved)
- **iEngage** presented a church-wide Social Media Policy (approved)

#### Faith Formation

- ♦ To change the official name of Presbyterian Weekday Nursery School (PWNS) to *First Presbyterian Preschool*, for clarity and better understanding in the community (**approved**)
- To allow Presbys to collect pet-related items this Christmas for a service project at Lakeshore PAWS Dog Shelter. While some concerns were expressed that the recipient might not fit within FPC's mission guidelines, as it was a service project suggested by the teens and not a monetary fundraiser, it was approved.
- ♦ To allow the Read Across America Spring Read-a-thon (<u>approved</u>)
- To allow a small increase in monthly tuition for the preschool classes beginning in the 2024-2025 year (**approved**)

# > Session's Bylaws and Operating Policies & Procedures Task Force

To create a *Planning Team* of Session to envision and propose a plan for a Matthew 25-oriented project to be funded by seed money from the Sharing Table Project that would explore options as to how our church could serve children and their families in the community possibly reaching beyond the scope of our current preschool. (approved) (Once this Planning Team is formed, you will be hearing much more about its vision.)

# UPDATE ON THE WORK OF SESSION'S "POLITY TASKFORCE"

In September 2023, Session formed a "Polity Taskforce" to review, and where appropriate, to make recommendations to Session for updates to the Bylaws and to other policies and procedures of our church that belong in our Manual of Operations – a document of guidance that sets forth in detail "how things operate" in our day-to-day ministry here at First Presbyterian - Valparaiso. The Manual is available to new elders, deacons and others who join our church leadership such as session and ministry teams. The daily work of our ministries and mission changes over time, and last summer our resale shop experience, alerted Session to the need for some reviews and updates and thus Polity Taskforce was formed.

A regular periodic review of our foundational documents provides an opportunity to spot gaps in policies and procedures and to delete what is no longer needed. The Task Force is looking for what might be missing that would strengthen our ministries.

The taskforce includes Mary Linda Scott (primarily working with the resale shop), Judy Hollar (Clerk of Session), Pastor Kim Adams (ex-officio with a futuristic balcony view), Matt Byerly (Worship & music), Sharon Kinsey (Faith Formation), Linda Long (Treasurer & Resale Shop Administrative Commission) and Jim Hubbard (Personnel, the Resale AC and the Sharing Table).

- Our current bylaws only mention our resale shop and our preschool ministries in general terms, so the taskforce is recommending adding language to our bylaws that these are integrated auxiliary ministries of our congregation and, as the local court declared as to the Resale Shop, are not, and never have been independent organizations.
- 2) Revised policies and procedures for the Presbyterian Church Resale Shop were approved by Session in June and updated again late this fall to reflect accepting credit cards, better retailing practices, and volunteer training.
- 3) Specific policies and procedures for the preschool are being written along with the formation of a long-range planning team envisioning expansion of the preschool ministry to meet community needs for families with young children.
- 4) Our Facilities Use & Fees policy has been updated to guide decisions about priorities and use of our church building, pavilion and grounds.
- 5) A new Social Media Policy has been approved by Session.
- 6) Personnel policies are reviewed annually and were updated to include requirements for background checks for volunteers working with children in FPCV ministries.
- Review of each of our ministry teams is underway, including their scope of work, matters of rotating leadership, conflicts of interest, mission-distribution guidelines, place for leadership for Matthew 25 initiatives, and other policies & procedures to be clear about their relationship to the community and to the ministry of FPCV and its members.

As our elected, called and installed leadership, it is Session's responsibility to approve policies and procedures on behalf of the congregation. Session will review any proposed changes to the bylaws in detail and hope to make its recommendations at the Annual Congregational Meeting for approval of any proposed updated bylaws. Information regarding any proposed bylaws changes will be communicated in January, prior to the Annual Congregational Meeting.

We are so happy to be back in the classroom with the students. In this new year we look forward to hosting Parent Teacher Conferences to discuss all the students' successes and growth.


The children did a fantastic job on their Christmas Programs. They worked so hard for a few months, practicing and doing their best. We celebrated each other with our annual Cookie Walk.

#### CHRISTIAN FOOD PANTRY

During November, pantry hour volunteers were busy serving two hundred twenty-one families which provided food for six hundred twelve people. Also sixty -eight bags containing Thanksgiving dinner menu items and turkeys were given out. A surprise call from Northwest Health Porter offered turkeys. Luckily freezer space was found (thank you FUMC and Mickey for the help) for thirty-six more birds. At this writing more than one hundred holiday bags have been given to the pantry by Strack's on that program continued Calumet: and through Christmas. The fundraiser program through the Meijer store continued through December with a doubling day on the 16th. The pantry is very fortunate to be well supported by our seven congregations along with individuals, organizations and businesses in our community as we continue to assist neighbors in our community in need of pantry help. This support comes in many forms such as monetary donations, food, health, cleaning and paper supplies as well as time, energy, muscle and prayer. All of this support is greatly appreciated.
