SESSION SYNOPSIS OF JANUARY 21, 2019

Newly installed Elders on Session joined those previously installed to serve in 2019 on Monday evening, January 21st. Parish Associate and appointed Moderator Rev. Nancy Becker moderated the meeting in which Session:

- Began with devotions led by Andrea Phillips that focused on hospitality founded upon unbounded, heartfelt gratitude that expresses God's love. After prayer, she summarized that "hospitality is love in action" and urged Session members to live out hospitality by committing to host coffee hour for our congregation during the coming weeks.
- Approved <u>One Family Services at 10:00 a.m. for March 17th, April 14th (Palm Sunday) and May 19th (Confirmation Sunday)</u> as intergenerational worship services that focus on "Living in Faith Together" (LIFT). Ken Crews and the Worship and Christian Education Committees are planning engaging worship with plenty of information about what to expect.
- Affirmed the Congregational Nominating Committee's panel for the congregation to consider for election to the <u>Pastoral Nominating Committee</u> ("PNC"). After prayer and subject to affirmation, Session named Lisa Pavlopoulos as its nominated representative on the PNC.
- Approved Harry Karabel's request on behalf of <u>Boy Scouts of America Troop #920</u> that our congregation reaffirm its charter as a continuing relationship with our congregation; Session approved including the expectation that girls will also be invited to join the troop.
- Issued a call for the <u>Annual Congregational and corporate meeting</u> for Sunday, January 27th, at 10 a.m. CST to approve the 2018 Annual Report, receive the 2019 Operating Budget, note officers for the Corporation as elected by Session (Elizabeth Monroe, President, and Ken McAloon, Secretary), elect members-at-large to the 2019 Congregational Nominating Committee, and to elect the Pastoral Nominating Committee.
- Established the worship schedule for the seasons of Lent, Easter and spring through Confirmation Sunday. Approved request for a congregational recycle/reuse "Garage Sale" on June 1st.
- <u>Re-elected</u> Judy Hollar as Clerk of Session, Ruth Dickey as Treasurer, Susan Grosick as Membership Clerk, and Andrea Phillips as its second Elder to the Nominating Committee. Session approved extending Ken Crews' contract to full time as Director of Christian Education and Youth Ministry to allow more time for consultation with various congregational committees.
- Thanked the <u>Pastoral Care Team</u> headed by Elizabeth Monroe that is visiting and praying with hospitalized and recuperating congregational members; Matt Byerly for temporarily and artfully directing the choir; and so many others who are stepping into <u>leadership roles</u> during this transitional time.

Elected its <u>commissioners to the presbytery assemblies</u> for 2019 and approved the 2018 annual statistical report.


